

2024 SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES

This Schedule is reviewed annually.

Tuition Fees and Related Charges

Pre-Kindergarten

Fees for the Pre-K class are based on the number of days the child attends. There are no related charges incurred.

- Two (2) Days: \$1,892 per term
- Three (3) Days: \$2,760 per term

Related Charges

Related Charges cover the majority of compulsory costs that apply to students in each cohort including (but not limited to) educational activities/events, incursions, excursions, carnivals and other services and resources provided to students.

Sibling Discounts (K-12)

Concessions are given on the Tuition Fees of younger siblings studying concurrently, with the exception of Pre-Kindergarten students:

- Second, and younger, sibling: 20%
- Third, and younger, sibling: 50%
- Subsequent, and younger, siblings: 100%

Other Costs

Co-curricular Programmes

There are levies for some co-curricular programmes.

Elective Subjects

There are Subject levies associated with some practical subjects in Years 9 to 12.

External Courses

Families will bear the cost of external courses; however, the School may make a contribution. This includes Distance Education, TAFE and other courses.

Bus Transport

There is a separate charge for School-operated bus services.

Vacation Care

A per-day rate is charged for Vacation care outside normal school days.

Before and After School Care (BASC)

BASC is separately charged. Charges exclude the Government rebate for which some families are eligible.

7:30am to 8:10am and 3:00pm to 6:00pm

Junior School (Wentworth Falls)

Note: **Only After School Care available**

2:50 to 5:30pm.

Voluntary Contributions

Blue Mountains Grammar School operates Building, Scholarship and Library Funds with deductible gift recipient status. These funds support the development of the School and students who would otherwise be unable to attend. Families are encouraged to contribute to these funds. The recommended donation to the Building Fund is \$150 per family, per term.

Payments

Fees and charges are invoiced before the commencement of each term, four times per year, excluding Year 12, which is invoiced over three terms.

Families have a range of options as to the pattern of payment of their fees:

1. To pay the full year's fees in full before the start of Term 1 – this option attracts a 2% discount.
2. To establish a direct debit payment plan, from a bank account or credit card, consisting of:
 - quarterly instalments made prior to the start of each term; or
 - ten monthly payments beginning on February 15th and concluding on November 15th.

The School no longer accepts cash payments, however, we can make alternate short-term arrangements for payment using a credit card, BPay or cheques.

Application for Enrolment Lodgement Fee

A service fee of \$135 is payable to lodge an Application for Enrolment form.

Registration Fee

A non-refundable fee of \$1,150 is payable to secure an enrolment. For families with more than two children attending BMGS at the same time, a maximum of two Registration Fees per family applies.

Withdrawal of Students

A full term's notice of withdrawal of a student must be given in writing to the Principal. In default of such, a full term's fees will be charged. Holiday periods do not constitute appropriate notice.
